July 4th 1791 Mr. Joseph McManning makes application for and entry of the North East corner of the first Section in the Second township East of the Great Miami and Second Entire range of townships North of the Ohio which Section is the property of Doct. William Burnet & Company. This applicant who is actually a volunteer Settler in the purchase prays the benefit of obtaining One hundred and Six acres of land which becomes forfeited in Said Section by reason of Non Settlement or representation by the Said Doct. Burnet & Company agreeably to the terms of Sale and Settlement.

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July 5, 1791 Doct. Calvin Morrell who is actually a Volunteer Settler in the purchase makes application for and Entry of the thirty Second Section the North East Corner thereof in the fourth township East from the Great Miami and Second fractional range North from the Ohio, which Section is the property of John Carpenter.

This applicant prays the Benefit of Obtaining One hundred and Six Acres of land which becomes forfeited in the Said Section by reason of Non Settlement or representation therof by the Said John Carpenter agreeably to the terms of Sale & Settlement.

July 6th, 1791. Benjamin Flinn of North Bend who is really a volunteer Settler in this place makes application for and Entry of the North East Corner of the thirty fourth Section in the Second township East of the Great Miami River and in the first entire range of townships North of the Ohio River which Section was located by Daniel Marsh Wm Burnet & Wm. Tindal Esqrs. This applicant prays the benefit of Obtaining One hundred and Six Acres of land which become forfeited in the Said Section by reason Non Settlement or representation theresis by the Said Marsh, Burnet or Tindal, agreeable to the terms of Sale & Settlement.

July 6th, 1791. John Burgrant Enters himself for the forfeiture of the Eighteenth Section in the fourth township in the first Entire range which Section is located on behalf of Doct. Jacob Jennings this applicant prays the benefit of obtaining a Sixth part thereof which becomes forfeited by reason of Non Settlement or representation thereof.

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July 6th, 1791. Henry Moore of South Bend who is a Volunteer Settler in this purchase makes application for and entry of the North East Corner of the thirty first Section in the fourth township East of the Great Miami River and in the first fractional range of townships North of the Ohio River, which Section is the property of Jonathan Dayton Esqr. This applicant prays the benefit of obtaining One hundred and Six Acres of land which becomes forfeited in Said Section by reason of Non Settlement or representation by Said Dayton agreeable to the terms of Sale and Settlement.

Henry Moore left the purchase Decr. 1st, 1791
